### LAST MEETING – 7<sup>th</sup> JUNE – VIRTUAL MEETING



Our June meeting was due to be the lecture from established author and card worker Paul Gordon. As you might expect, given the current situation, we had no alternative but to postpone the lecture until we (and Paul!) feel that it would be safe to reschedule it. So, in place of the lecture we decided to hold an online virtual club meeting so that members could at least spend some time together and share latest effects and routines.

Although it was a fairly short session, there was a useful discussion about magic in the lockdown situation and how it might have to change to avoid spectator contact with any props etc. Some felt that re-assessing material (or bringing in new non-contact material) would be a good idea in the short term. Others pointed out that the public has a short memory, and felt that once the restrictions are lifted, things may well simply go back to how they were before. For now, although restaurants are to be open again in early July, it appears that live entertainment of any description is still forbidden in places like this. As a result, public magic performances of all descriptions will continue to be on hold for the time being.

The session ended with Nathan showing us all some the new card material he's been working on, along with contributions from Finlay too. Thanks both – good to see how you're keeping your hand in!

## ADDITIONAL MEETING – 28th JUNE – WEB OF SECRETS SHOW AND LECTURE

On Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> June, the club got together with Mid Essex Magical Society to put on a joint online session featuring Matthew Wright in his 'Web of Secrets' show and lecture.

The Web of Secrets is a completely new and unique online interactive show designed to bring amazement, wonder, comedy and all round entertainment directly into the spectator's own home. Matthew has made his name running



his own magic theatre in the Costa del Sol in Spain, where his show "The Chamber of Secrets" has been the Trip Advisor number one attraction for the past 5 consecutive years. During lockdown, Matthew has decided to offer magic clubs a combined show and lecture package which we were keen to take advantage of.

The first part of the evening, which was attended by around 30 members, consisted of the show. Clever use of technology allowed Matthew to run the whole event himself, using a mix of live interaction, video clips and overlays, and 3 cameras to keep things moving and engaging. It was a brilliant use of the platform, and the show, which took Matthew 4 days to write, contained plenty of varied material. During the hour we were treated to:

- a freely selected card to mouth routine (although the name of the card was actually written on a dollar bill!);
- a lovely three-fly coins across routine where the final coin visibly floats from one hand to the other;
- a drawing duplication using a spectator's phone, along with a thought of card prediction;
- a blindfolded Rubik's cube solve;
- a beautiful torn and restored card effect (called D4M) with the card being restored in a mixed up fashion:
- a take on the three shell game with the use of Matthew's own design of Lippincott box;
- a signed 'bill to walnut in orange' routine;
- an online colour match effect where the spectator's drawing perfectly matches a prediction made ahead of time;
- and finally a brilliantly thought out mentalism routine involving photos of rescue dogs. The outcomes had all been shown ahead of the routine itself in a special film.

The whole thing was superbly put together and contained some really strong material which was thoroughly enjoyed by everyone on the call.

Next came the lecture part of the evening where Matthew generously explained most of the effects he had performed in the show.

It was a superb evening and thanks go to Matthew for staging it – I hope those members that joined in enjoyed it as much as I did!



## ADDITIONAL ONLINE MEETING – 7<sup>th</sup> JULY – ETIENNE PRADIER LECTURE

For those that aren't familiar with Etienne's work, you're in for a real treat!

Born in France, Etienne became fascinated by magic at an early age and rapidly made a name for himself as a truly gifted close-up magician that was assured to be "going somewhere." And he did ... twice!

He moved to England and achieved international recognition as one of the world's finest close-up table magicians. After only 3 years as a member of the elite 'Magic Circle', he was invited to take membership of the 'Inner Magic Circle, with Gold Star' in recognition of his excellence as a professional magician



Etienne has worked all around the world and has won many awards during his 25 years of performing magic at the highest level. He is one of only 200 people to be presented a gold star membership of the Inner Magic Circle. He has won Magic Circle Magician of the Year, Colombe d'Or in France, came 3rd in the world Championships in Holland, and won the All Winner Championship Cup in England.

So when he announced that he was offering live online lectures, it was one of those things that we needed to get booked early, because we knew how popular the offer would be. Mid Essex Magical Society (MEMS) had the same idea, so we're now pleased to be able to offer you the chance to see the lecture first hand with a joint event for us and MEMS.



#### **Sponge Balls**

#### **SUPER MULTI BALL by Aprendemagia**

It's not just a new magic trick; it is a new super multi functional tool to create magic with sponge balls. It's about a triple colour change; red, green and blue - with the same sponge ball! But at the same time it allows you to grab extra balls to perform multiplying balls; or to split colours, or change from secondary colours to primary colours. Or you can add multiple objects such as silks and dice. This new gimmicked ball opens a world of visual possibilities, such as empty hands colour changes with no extra loads.

It comes with an explanation video that's goes deep into all the possibilities that this ball gives you. Also covered are how to use it, how to care for it, the ways to display it and spectator considerations.



This is a super multi ball that opens a new way of performing magic with sponge balls, far more visual and combinable with all the classic sponge ball tricks to enhance them and generate a stronger climax.

## **Utility Items**

#### WRITE, NOT RIGHT by Wayne Dobson

Wayne has turned his attention to mentalism, developing a brilliant yet simple utility device for the working mentalist. It's a Sharpie that writes. Then when the mentalist/magician decides, doesn't write.



Or it's a Sharpie that doesn't write. Then when the mentalist/magician decides, it does write.

Unlike any other gimmicked Sharpie pen on the market, you can show and use the pen as normal from the outset. Then when you want to, hand it to the spectator -- it doesn't write. If it suits your working practice, you can do it the other way around. You can even end up with the pen writing again!

Experienced mentalists will immediately recognize the value of such a tool, and will also welcome the simplicity of its manufacture.

Each Sharpie is carefully hand-made.

The device comes with handling notes from Marc Spelmann.

## THE MEDAL by Harry Robson & Matthew Wright



Following our evening with Matthew Wright the other day I thought I'd include some of his effects in the newsletter.....

It only takes a second to create a moment of magic...but that moment can last forever. Harry Robson has spent a lifetime in magic creating this moment and for the first time has decided to share it with the magic community.

The Medal is a high quality, built-to-last prop that is perfect for all performing environments.

A medal is displayed in full view throughout the performance. It can be worn around your neck, the spectator's neck, laid on the table or even kept inside a box. A card is freely selected from the deck. It can be chosen by taking a card, looking at a card from a face-up spread, cutting the deck, counting down to a card... whatever way you prefer. The reverse side of **The Medal** is now shown to be engraved with the selected card. It is really engraved (no semantics).

Everything for the effect can be carried in a single pocket and can be reset in seconds.

Comes with everything you need to start performing straight away. Very easy to do and comes with bonus routines from FISM award winner Matthew Wright.

The Medal costs around £50, but if you visit Matthew's lecture page you can get it along with two other effects for the same price!



#### **Impossible Location Magic**

**NUT DROPPER by Matthew Wright** 

Instantly load any small object inside a walnut, inside a fruit.....one handed!

The "borrowed item to impossible location" is a classic of magic and for good reason. It always generates great reactions and interest because the props are personal to the spectator. It leaves itself open to great comedy, interaction, tension and suspense. It is an essential part of any good magic act.



The Marvellous Nut Dropper is by far one of the best in terms of routine, presentation, method and simplicity.

Included on a 2 DVD set are three different routines taken directly from Matthew's repertoire..... although they are in fact complete acts on their own.

The first, "The Wizard's Apprentice" is a full twenty minute opener to a cabaret show. It has been tried and tested hundreds of times in front of live audiences and never fails to get reactions. Included in the routine is a full explanation of a finger ring on string routine and also a cups & balls routine.

The second routine is Matthew's "Double or Nothing" Bar Set. This is a full twenty minute gambling act including a "which hand" prediction routine where not only do you correctly guess three times which hand the object is in, but also show that you had predicted the outcome from the very start.

The final routine on the DVD is a fun, powerful, simple and very commercial walk-around table trick. "The Orange Nutwork" is an original plot where a borrowed SIM card is lost and found inside a walnut inside an orange. It has many gags built into it and is a great closer for any close-up performance.

The DVD also has many bonus features including extra routines that utilize the gimmicks on the DVD.

You will of course also receive the "Marvellous Nut Dropper" gimmick which allows you with one hand to instantly load a small object inside a walnut, inside a fruit.

This product is suitable for every type of performer at any level of experience. The routines can be used close-up, parlour or stage and range from completely self working to some very technical knuckle busting sleight of hand.
