### LAST MEETING – 3<sup>rd</sup> JUNE – OPEN CLB NIGHT



The June meeting was one of our open club nights, and although it was fairly poorly attended (probably due to holidays, the heat and the extra meeting scheduled for the following Sunday), those of us that were there had a lovely relaxed evening talking and sharing magic.

Not much to report other than that to be honest, but thanks to all that attended.

## EXTRA MEETING – 10<sup>th</sup> JUNE – JAMY IAN SWISS LECTURE

The Jamy Ian Swiss lecture was held on 10<sup>th</sup> June and what a great lecture it was, with loads of professional tips and effects from a seasoned professional.

Jamy was meticulous in his crediting of various magicians when presenting the different routines, and went into a great deal of detail about the various sleights and handlings used so that everyone could see exactly how things worked.



The first half of the lecture was almost entirely devoted to card effects.

Jamy opened with an ambitious card sequence, followed by his 'remote card in impossible location'. He described various versions involving different impossible locations including a pocket watch, a ball of wool, a wallet and a match-book. Four ladies (the Queens) found the Four of Hearts sandwiched between them, while a card was 'shot' into the pack to locate a chosen card with a miscalled subtlety as a convincer. This was 'The World's Most Difficult Card Trick'.

Jamy then moved on to a time-travel theme, using a squeeze-purse from the 1970s, first for a card to purse effect and then for a coin-in-purse routine – this was used to mislead those who thought they had an idea of how the first routine was accomplished!

This led to Jamy's thoughts on the card in ring box effect. Jamy had developed 'The Big Apple' for his bar work - a sweet jar which could show the folded card moving around inside among the sweets before being tipped out.

Jamy went on to discuss the use of a card fold and discussed the benefits of a three way fold, made under a card spread, as opposed to the more popular Mercury card-fold.

J.C. Wagner's 'Factory Misprints' effect was presented, and Jamy then showed us some superb coin work using silver dollars in a coins-across sequence called 'Me-Fly'. This involved the use of his own sleight that enables a secret, noiseless pass of a stack of coins from one hand to the other. At the end of the move you're also able to show both hands empty!

Jamy is well known for his cups and balls work, and his masterclass on the effect was lovely to see. Using a wand to great effect, his routine is largely based on Vernon's, so there was discussion on the Vernon wand spin, some excellent advice on how to analyse every move so that the magic can be maximised, and a description of how to produce a full shot glass as the final load.

Card-on- ceiling was also explored, apparently using a drawing pin as well as the usual wax methods, and revealing how the wax could be secretly added in a variety of ways.

In the end it was a fairly long lecture and we certainly got great value for money from a hugely experienced professional. Jamy was kind enough to say that he'd found us to be the best audience on his tour so far, and that he hoped we'd got the lecture we deserved!

At the meeting we also welcomed three new members to the Society – Margaret Winston, Suzanne Barr and David Hall. Congratulations and welcome to the club! We hope you enjoy your membership and find it both helpful and rewarding. I'm sure our other members will do everything they can to make you feel welcome.

# NEXT MEETING – 1<sup>st</sup> JULY – DIXON SHOWS PLANNING/REHEARSAL NIGHT

Our July meeting is an opportunity to have a think about the Dixon shows and to look at trying to finalise a shows roster. 

## TIC TAC TOE PRO by Bond Lee

A classic paper and pencil game between two players has now turned into an interactive game between the magician and audience. Each player takes turns drawing X's and O's on a 3-by-3 grid. After completing the game, the magician reveals a surprise ending!



### Contents:

6 pieces made of acrylic plastic, all held together by magnets; and 9 pieces of X's and O's.

You can customise the prediction as you wish, for example as the finale to a mentalism routine, or revealing a message, photo or company logo. There are 2 sizes available to accommodate both parlour and stage use. Tic Tac Toe Pro is designed to be disassembled, making it very easy to carry.

Prices are £144.95 for the parlour version; and £289.90 for the much larger stage version.

#### **Mentalism**

### **PENILISM by Vortex Magic**



If you perform mentalism or magic, you are going to love this amazing tool by vortex magic. Penilism is a multi-functional pen that looks like a regular pen but gives you the ability to easily switch colours from red to blue to black, as well as writing without any ink. One pen with four different functions and it's easy to use.

Confabulation - what you write down can now be in a different colour than your final prediction - taking any-type of confabulation routine to a much higher level.

Any double writing routine - any time you need to double write, you can now change colours live and without the spectator noticing. The pen looks like a regular writing pen but is designed so you can easily switch between colours.

X-marks the spot - the pen also has the ability to write, then when you ask the spectator to write, no ink comes out. This is great for so many mentalism routines from book tests to drawing routines. It is the perfect tool for forcing a word, a picture, or a number.

A great envelope routine - this routine first appeared in vanish magic magazine and is a great use of Penilism. You show an envelope with a prediction inside, and you write a prediction on the outside in red ink. When the prediction inside is opened, the prediction matches -- plus it is also in black ink. An added touch that takes this type or routine to a different level.

What you receive: One multi-functional pen, a pen bag, a DP switching envelope and a download with various ideas and routines on how to use the pen.



### **Cards**

### **VOYAGE** by Jean-Pierre Vallarino

A blue back prediction card is placed inside an open envelope. It is visible to all the spectators from the beginning of the routine and will be never hidden. In a deck of card with different backs (of your choice), ask the spectator to choose and sign a card and then lose it in the deck of cards.



At this point, everybody thinks it's over...Ask the spectator to take his signed card and turn it over... It's a red back card!!! 3 great colour changes with this routine of impossible travel! The envelope can be examined by the spectators. The signed card found in the envelope is genuinely the spectator's card.

Phone Magic KLIK by Agus Tjiu



Welcome to Klik! With just one click from a spectator's camera phone, they can witness the card literally changing as they take the shot and capture it in the fairest way in their phone gallery.

Effect: Spectator selects a card from the deck. The magician finds the wrong card. The spectator holds up this incorrect card, and a photo is taken using their camera phone. When the photo is viewed, the card has changed to the correct card, held by the spectator! Incredible!

No augmented reality No apps required No switch Just a single card - Klik

#### Features:

2 special gaff cards, the 3 of Spades and 8 of Clubs. The magic happens in their hand, on their own camera phone. The effect works automatically. Klik is available in blue or red back.
